Introduction: “THANKS” scholarships were established in 2008 to help KEMU students with their tuition. The acronym “THANKS” represents Tuition Help from Alumni for New KE Students. These are need-based scholarships with the ultimate goal of meeting the tuition assistance needs of all students admitted to KEMU on merit basis.

Info for Recipients

1. Who is eligible to apply for these scholarships?

New scholarships are primarily available to **first year** students.

2. What are the eligibility criteria?

These are **need-based** scholarships for students at KEMU. The financial need assessment is primarily through the application completed by the student.

3. How long will each THANKS scholarship provide tuition assistance?

Each THANKS scholarship will provide yearly tuition for up to five years. Each THANKS scholarship will be renewed every year as long as the student continues to succeed academically. After graduation, another student will reap the same benefit, another student after that, and yet another student after that and so on.

4. How do I apply for a THANKS scholarship?

Application for applying for a THANKS scholarship is available KEMCAANA's web site. The same application is used to apply for **all** KEMCAANA Endowment Scholarships. This application should be completed and submitted electronically.

5. What are the requirements to be eligible to renew the scholarship?

The student must remain enrolled at KEMU and pass all exams.

6. What is the selection process for THANKS scholarships?

Applications for THANKS Scholarships and KEMCAANA Endowment Scholarships are solicited each year, depending on the number of available slots for new scholarships. KEMU has a standing Scholarship Committee appointed by the Vice Chancellor and consists of 3 professors at KEMU. After carefully confirming the financial information, the Scholarship Committee interviews the students and selects the students for all the scholarships.

7. What is the mechanism for payment of these scholarships?

Each year, one-year tuition amount will be given directly to the KEMU admission office. For students who have already paid the annual tuition prior to their selection for the THANKS scholarships, the full tuition amount for one year will be reimbursed directly to the student in one lump sum.

FAQs:

KEMCAANA's "THANKS" Scholarships

1. What does the name "THANKS" represent?

These scholarships provide us the opportunity to say **THANKS** to our alma mater. We are indeed blessed to have this opportunity to show our gratitude to Almighty and to the institution that enabled us to be in this position.

"THANKS" stands for:

Tuition **H**elp from **A**lumni for **N**ew **KE** **S**tudents

2. What is the purpose of these scholarships?

These scholarships will provide tuition assistance to medical students of KEMU.

3. What is the goal of these scholarships?

The goal of "THANKS" scholarships is to make the KEMU a tuition-free institution for students admitted on merit basis.

4. What is the minimum amount of donation to establish a scholarship?

The minimum donation to establish a scholarship is \$ 5000.00. This amount will progressively increase in future.

5. Are these named scholarships?

Each scholarship will be in the name of the donor unless the donor decides to remain anonymous. The donor may also establish the scholarship in somebody else's name.

6. Can a scholarship be established with a smaller donation?

Contributions in any amount are welcome. A scholarship is named, however, only after the full amount needed to establish a scholarship has been received.

7. Are these funds managed separately from the other KEMCAANA Scholarships funds?

No. The KEMCAANA treasurer oversees the KEMCAANA Scholarship Endowment account. These funds are invested under the direction of the investment committee appointed by the KEMCAANA Executive Council.

8. How are the students selected for these scholarships?

KEMU/KEMCAANA Scholarship committees identify students primarily on financial need basis.

9. How do these scholarships differ from other KEMCAANA scholarships?

THANKS scholarships are for tuition assistance. Our regular scholarships provide financial support for education that includes all education related expenses. The donation needed to establish a THANKS scholarship is \$5,000.00 whereas the amount needed to establish a regular scholarship is \$10,000.00.

10. How long will each scholarship provide tuition assistance?

These contributions will become part of the KEMCAANA endowment. Each gift enables a KE student to have free education for five years. After five years, another student will reap the same benefit, another student the following five year, yet another student after that and so on. **This contribution is a gift that keeps on giving.**

11. What are we thankful for?

We are thankful for the five magical years at our alma mater where we had the best teachers and made our lifelong friends. The pictorial web pages for these scholarships provide us an ideal way to thank the people in our lives who helped us be what we are today.

12. Are the donations tax deductible?

Yes. KEMCAANA is a 501/ C3 organization and all donations are tax deductible

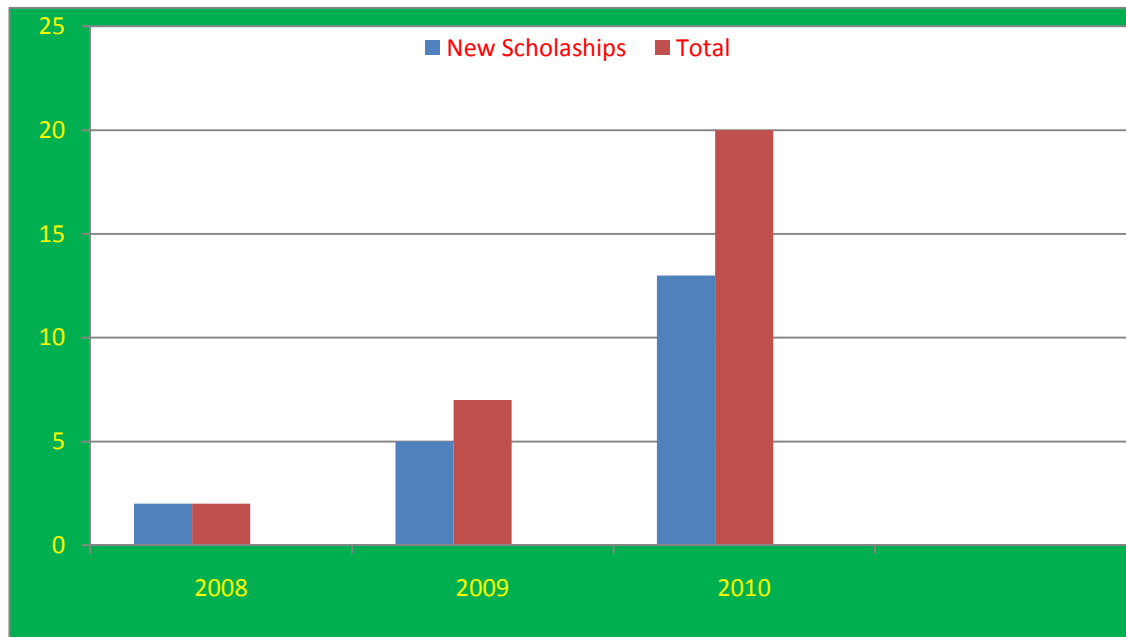

THANKS Scholarship Committee

1. Membership in THANKS scholarship committee is open to all KE alumni who establish a THANKS scholarship.
2. Anybody who establishes a THANKS scholarship automatically becomes a member of the THANKS scholarship committee for three calendar years (two full years and some days.)
3. The membership becomes effective the day a THANKS scholarship is established by the donor. Since the KEMCAANA business year starts from Jan 1, the duration of the first year membership will be shorter and will depend when the scholarship is established. The second year of membership will start from the next Jan 1 and the third year of membership will end on December 31.
4. Establishment of each additional scholarship will provide three more years of membership.
5. Currently all donors of the THANKS scholarship are members of the THANKS scholarship committee. The membership in the committee will expire on 12-31-2013 for those who have established one scholarship and 12-31-2016 for those who have established two scholarships. Addition of a new scholarship by any donor will extend the membership for additional three years.
6. Membership in THANKS scholarship committee is on a voluntary basis. No compensation of any sort is available for this work.
